ANNUAL CONFERENCE PROCEDURES

In our desire to return to in-person gatherings for Annual Conference, in a way that ensures the safety of all participants, the following protocols are being implemented:

COVID-19 / CDC PROTOCOLS

- 1. Everyone who attends the Conference is required to take a **COVID-19 test** prior to attending the Conference.
- 2. Acceptable COVID tests include Antigen (Rapid), PCR and home tests.
- If you test positive, please follow the CDC quarantine guidelines. Notify anyone you have come in contact with, who may be at risk of exposure.
- 4. Masks are optional during the conference. However, if you are coughing, you should definitely wear a mask, even if you are negative for COVID.
- 5. Anyone experiencing COVID symptoms should stay home. You are excused from the conference.

PASTORAL / PRESIDING ELDER REPORTS

6. Each Pastor is expected to report their completed Pastoral Report form online as requested on due dates of information prior to the opening day of their Annual Conference. The <u>financial report</u> from each local church is to be reported to the Presiding Elder at least two (2) weeks prior to the opening date of the conference. Presiding Elders are required to submit their comprehensive reports with summaries; pastoral reports, names and addresses of each subscriber to periodicals, and participants in the ministerial annuity program under one cover.

MUSIC MINISTRY

 Choir members of all local churches of the conference are asked to join the Annual Conference Choir. Your voice and talent is needed as a source of inspiration and praise.

VESTMENTS

8. Presiding Elders and Ordained Clergy are to bring their robes to conference - white for Opening and black for Closing. All ordained clergy are expected to wear black/white clergy shirts/blouses with clergy collar for the Opening and Closing services. During the Annual Conference only wear black, blue or gray attire.
